

The Educational Opportunity Center

(EOC) is a federal grant program, funded by the U.S. Department of Education. The goal of the EOC program is to encourage low-income, underrepresented individuals to pursue their educational studies beyond high school and to provide assistance and counseling to those individuals.



The mission of the EOC program is to help individuals achieve their **educational goals** which will ultimately lead to new career choices, opening new doors. Each individual chooses their own path, however the EOC program equips them with the necessary tools to be successful along that path.

Am I eligible?

To be eligible for program services you must meet the

- Are you at least 18 years of age
- You are a United States citizen or a national of the U.S.; or a permanent resident; or are in the U.S. for other than a temporary purpose and can provide evidence from the Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS).
- Must reside in one of the following counties: Austin, Brazoria, Chambers, Colorado, Fort Bend, Galveston, Harris, Liberty, Matagorda, Montgomery, Waller, Walker, or Wharton.
- Expresses a desire to enroll, or is enrolled in a program of post-secondary education or GED program. Individuals with a high school diploma or GED are also eligible.
- A veteran regardless of age if he or she satisfied the

How to Apply

In an effort to assess individual needs, students must meet program eligibility requirements and complete an initial intake application which will be reviewed by an EOC counselor.
